- To comply with School Board policy Code of Virginia § 22.1-253.13:7 (which requires a 5-year review process)
- To ensure policy updates are made in a timely manner
- To partner with LCPS community, staff and stakeholders to develop and improve policies

HOW THE PROCESS WORKS



Approximate 4-Month Process

MONTH 1
Draft and Review

MONTH 2
Primary Committee (Information Item)
School Board standing committees typically meet once monthly

MONTH 3
Primary Committee (Action Item)

MONTH 4
Full School Board (Information and Action Item)
School Board typically meets twice monthly, except July, August and December
