Aldie, VA—Ms. Susan Hollinger, a 4th generation Loudoun native and resident of Aldie, was recently named as John Champe High School's Math Department Chair. A teacher at Broad Run High School, Ms. Hollinger has been teaching there since 1998 where she currently teaches Advanced Algebra/Pre-Calculus, Math Analysis, and Functions and Data Analysis. Ms. Hollinger earned her Bachelor's of Science in math from the College of William and Mary, and she holds a Master's in Secondary Education from Marymount University. Ms. Hollinger's past experiences in LCPS include teaching nearly all levels of math, leaving her very familiar with the curriculum and the changing needs of students at many different levels. She is currently participating in the Teacher Leadership Series pilot group at BRHS, and she has chaired the county-wide common assessment committee for math analysis and has participated in several other curriculum committees, all of which have helped prepare her for the role of department chair. Ms. Hollinger's goal is to work collaboratively with her colleagues to make math engaging and relevant to students while also enhancing their study skills.
