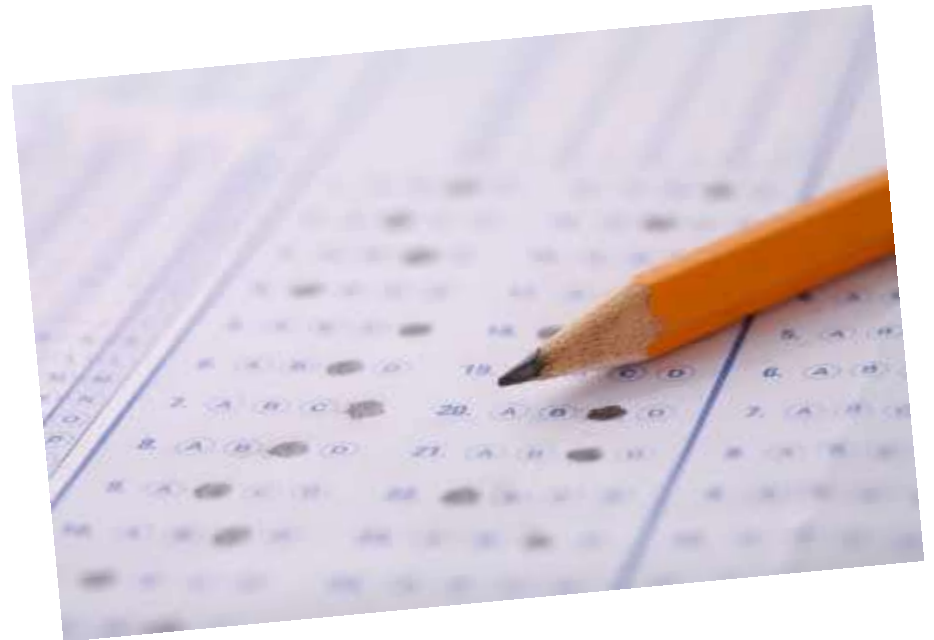
# ATTENTION NHS

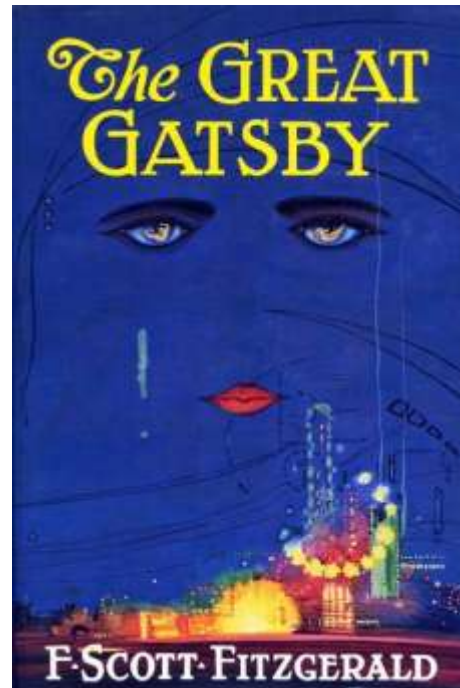

# DMV MEMBERS



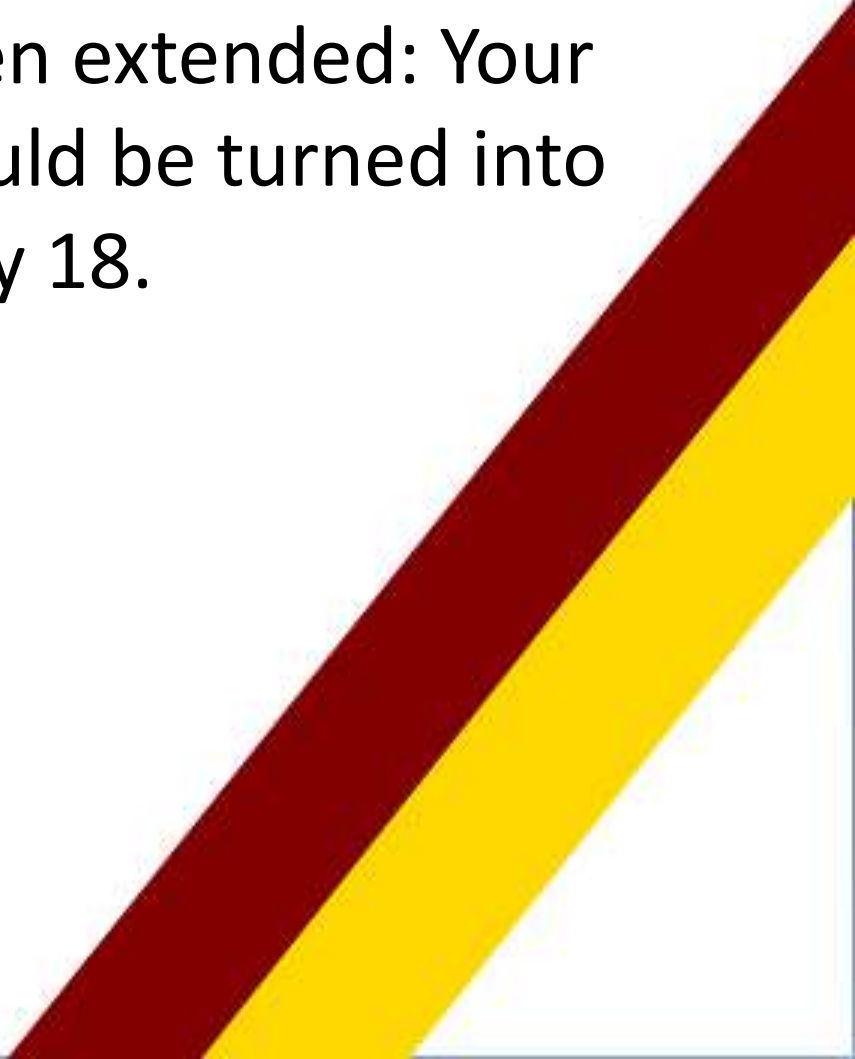
# LOST AND FOUND ITEMS
