

Tuskie's Restaurant Group Culinary Arts Scholarship

The Tuskie's Restaurant Group 2-Year Culinary Arts Scholarship is a long-term, continuing program available to graduates of the Culinary Arts program at Monroe Technology Center and accepted as full-time students at an accredited culinary arts school in Fall of 2018. A \$2,500 per year TRG Culinary Arts Scholarship will be awarded to one full-time student each year planning to attend a 2-or-4-year culinary arts school. The initial \$2,500 award of the scholarship will be made by a committee including Joy Anderson, Timothy Flynn, and a representative of the Tuskie's Restaurant Group.

The scholarship award will be open to all graduates of the Monroe Tech culinary arts program. The awarding of the scholarship will be based upon the student's grade point average at Monroe Tech, the attitude they exhibit as a culinary arts student at Monroe Tech, the student's financial need, and the completion of a 300-500 word Essay telling why they wish to pursue a career in the culinary arts.

The awarding of the second year of the scholarship will be based upon successful maintenance of a 3.0 average (or higher) at an accredited culinary arts school, and the student's submission of a transcript from their first year to the culinary arts teacher at MATA, who will assess their eligibility for the second year's award of \$2,500.

The cost to the Tuskie's Restaurant Group will be \$2,500 in calendar year 2014, and \$5,000 per year in subsequent years, assuming successful participation in an accredited culinary arts education by the students receiving the awards. While intended as a long-term program, the awarding of the scholarships each year will be based on the continuing business success of the Tuskie's Restaurant Group, and its ability to fund the program.
