It's important to study hard for true-or-false tests.

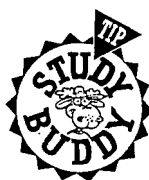


## Directions

Read the statements below. Circle the letter under *True* if a statement is true and circle the letter under *False* if a statement is false. If your answers are correct, you will circle letters that spell a question vertically.

## Directions

Read the following statements and the words in the word bank. Fill in the blanks with the correct answers.

- 1 Ask in advance if the test will give a word \_\_\_\_\_. If it will not, you know you have to memorize answers word for word.
- 2 If you are unsure of the \_\_\_\_\_ of a word, look to see if it is written somewhere in the text to help you.
- 3 If your answer sounds awkward, it is probably \_\_\_\_\_.
