A performance assessment allows students to demonstrate what they can do with what they know.

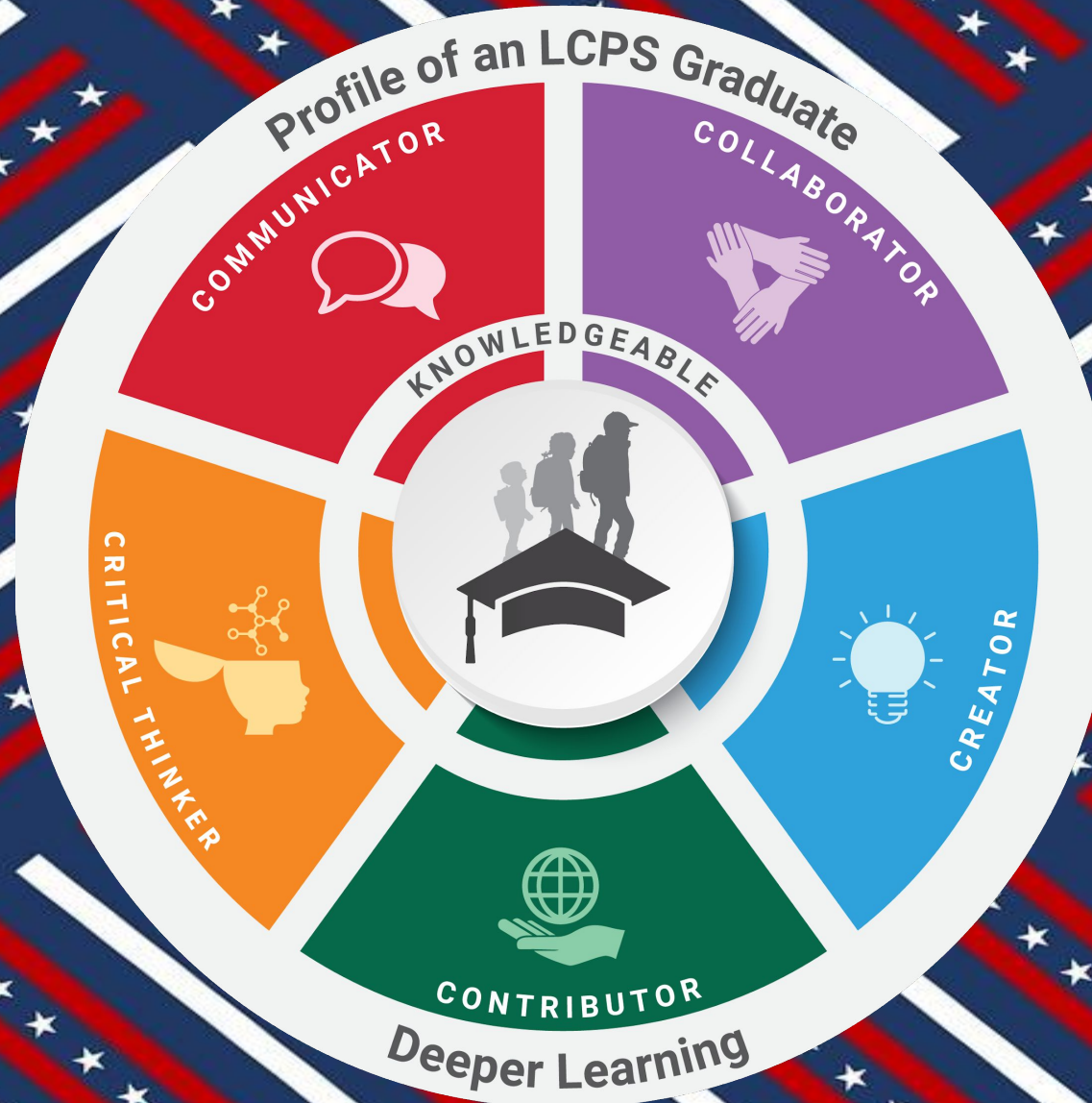


It asks students to think and to produce—to demonstrate learning through work authentic to the discipline and/or real world.

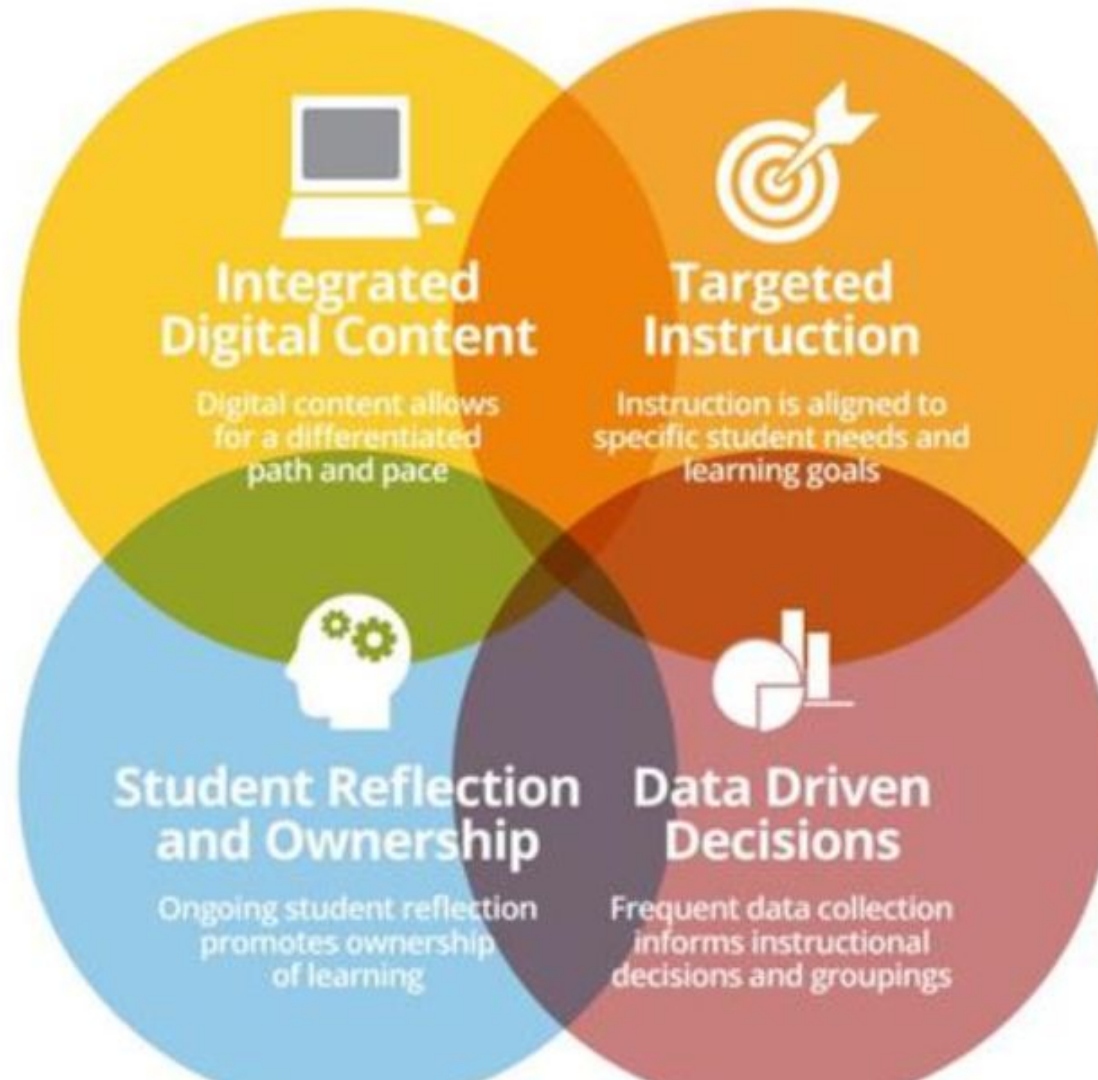
