

## AP Summer Assignment

**You need to sign up for : Remind.com and Google Classroom. See information on back for sign up information**

There are 2 parts:

- A written description about the exam itself (see part I)
- the scrapbook (see part II)

**I. Aufsatz über AP Prüfung- Upload to Google Classroom:** Go to the AP website for the German Language Exam and learn everything you can about the exam: format, scoring, length, date, etc.

There are several links to exam format, sample questions and audios, general information.

**Upload to GC** a 150 words minimum written word document **in English** that explains what you have learned about the exam and what parts of the test you think will be the hardest for you. Include some strategies for how you will prepare yourself for the course and ultimately for the test. **DO NOT COPY AND PAST FROM THE WEBSITE** – reflect on the exam format and on your strengths and weaknesses in German.

Due in Google Classroom by: **August 1<sup>st</sup>**. This is worth 100 points.

## **II. Summer Memories: Due: the first week of school**

- Throughout the summer, document your activities. Pick A or B.
  - a. Create a scrapbook with souvenirs and memories describing the people and events from your summer. Your scrapbook may be either in paper form or digitized in a format that can be presented in school. (I recommend either Powerpoint or Prezi). The scrapbook should have a title and should contain a minimum of 4-5 different activities/entries.
  - b. Create a one minute video that is a collection of clips from your summer. Each video clip should be between 2-5 seconds long. Your video must be an .mp4 file.
- You will be presenting your Summer Memories in a formal presentation during the opening days of school that should last between 5-6 min. and be well rehearsed.
- Everyone must turn it in the first week of class and then a presentation schedule will be established. (100 points total book/video and presentation).

- Add a class with the + sign. Use class code v6jhxx8 for Deutsch 5/AP**
  - Upload your College Board review by Aug. 1 and upload your summer video or scrapbook the first week of school.**
