There are **TWO** parts:

- a written description about the exam itself (see part I)
- a summary of **one** of the two short stories (see part II)

I. Ensayo del examen: Due August 1. Upload to Google Classroom.

Go to the AP website for the Spanish Literature Exam and learn everything you can about the exam: format, scoring, length, date, etc.

Upload to GC a 150 words minimum written word document **in English** that explains what you have learned about the exam and what parts of the test you think will be the hardest for you. Include some strategies for how you will prepare yourself for the course and ultimately for the test. **DO NOT COPY AND PAST FROM THE WEBSITE** – reflect on the exam format and on your strengths and weaknesses in Spanish. **Due in GC: August 1st. This is worth 100 points.**

II. Summer reading summary: Due the first week of school. Upload to Google Classroom.

You will pick one of the short stories that are in GC and you will write a 3 paragraph summary for the story that you choose. **(100 points).**
