## **STATEMENT OF INTEREST**

I've attached documentation to show I am a registered voter and a resident of the Catoctin District. Below is a brief description of my qualifications and some other material as specified in the announcement that the school board vacancy decision will be made on December 4, 2018. I look forward to make a brief statement at the November 26, 2018 School Board meeting as well.

I appreciate all the school board member time and consideration to allow me to rejoin the Loudoun School Board. I actively participated as a member of the school board over the 8 years I represented the Broad Run District. My wife and I chaperoned exchange students from Broad Run to China. I initiated the Mandarin Program and made significant advances while being chair of the finance committee for most of my time on the board. Although I believe my votes and participation is archived and available for review on the LCPS Video Program I am attaching a short list of votes taken during my two terms on the school board with my reasoning for your review.

I am proud of having only missed one board meeting over 8 years which was when I had to fly out to New Mexico to take care of my mother after my father died.

I only remember filing one expense report over 8 years to reimburse mileage costs to attend a board session in Williamsburg.

My purpose and actions have always been to serve the community not to take from the community. I never took a cent from anyone to support either of my school board election campaigns. I understand these are non-partisan positions so my current position as an independent should not block any board member from supporting me. I plan on working with all of you cooperatively without regard to party.

As further support that I will share some community involvements for your consideration and awareness:

10 years on the Good Shepherd Alliance Board helping homeless in Loudoun. Key member of Ashburn Village Group that blocked Dominion Power from putting an additional line of super large power lines through our neighborhood.

Spent years on other boards such as the Loudoun Bar board, Loudoun Crime Commission board. Participated in Lucketts Ruritans, Lucketts business collaborative, Christian Lawyers Society and Lucketts Food Pantry.

Published book on investment risk available on Amazon and was even certified as a responsible land disturber by the state of Virginia. My legal certifications (New York and Virginia) expanded to include the United States Supreme Court as well.

I created and taught a course on how to win large government contracts at NOVA

I founded, managed and played on Ashburn United Adult co-ed Soccer team

Supported many pro-bono clients over my 31 year legal career and believe my experience and community interest coincide with what will benefit the Loudoun County School Board.
