

# Grade Information

## 10pt assignments (formative)

*Process, sketches, short worksheets, etc. This is to check knowledge.*

or

## 100pt assignments (summative)

*Final assessments, projects, and longer activities. This is for the students to apply knowledge.*

### Final Projects

All projects are based on a rubric. A project rubric may have as few as 2 objectives, or 4 or more. **Each objective in a project is worth 100pts.** So, in the example below, this project would be worth three (3) 100pt grades, or 300 total points.

Students should always be aiming for a 3 or better on any project objective.

\*\*\*If students receive below a 3 on an assignment, they have 2 weeks after being given a grade or until the end of the quarter (*whichever comes first*) to bring that grade up, either by:

- redoing the assignment,
- improving the existing product,
- or completing relevant work for the project (more info on this on a case by case basis)\*\*\*
