## 10pt assignments (formative)

Process, sketches, short worksheets, etc. This is to check knowledge.

or

## 100pt assignments (summative)

Final assessments, projects, and longer activities. This is for the students to apply knowledge.

## Final Projects

All projects are based on a rubric. A project rubric may have as few as 2 objectives, or 4 or more. **Each objective in a project is worth 100pts**. So, in the example below, this project would be worth three (3) 100pt grades, or 300 total points.
