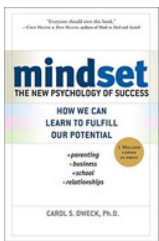
We have a new section in our professional development collection with several new titles. Take a look at some of the new titles we've added.

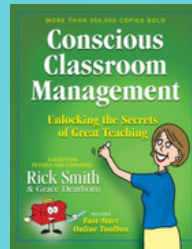

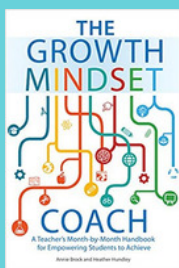

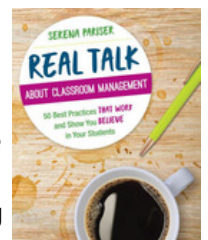
