

Bridge Programs

NOVA's summer Bridge Programs are focused on **Engineering Technology (ET)**, **Data Center Operations (DCO)**, **Information Technology (IT)**, and **Computer Science (CS)**. These programs provide students an opportunity to explore either ET/DCO or IT/CS through hands-on activities and industry site visits. Students will be introduced to NOVA's campuses, offices (e.g. student services, financial aid, etc.), and career pathways. Transportation will be provided between the two participating NOVA Campuses and any site tours or field trips conducted as part of the program. Students will need to drive to or be dropped off and picked up each day at the session campus closest to them. Bridge programs are free, but space is limited. Students may apply for one bridge program session.
