YAS FAQ

Do I need to come to the office to register for the 2015-2016 YAS program? YAS does not require anyone to register in person, even if you are new to PRCS programs. The simplest way to register for the 2015-2016 YAS program is to mail in your completed paperwork and check to us. We will mail or email you a receipt confirming that your child is registered for the 2015-2016 YAS program.

What is YAS? YAS stands for Youth After School and is an after school program for students attending middle school. Our program is designed to provide structured, supervised, recreational activities for students. Our experienced staff provides guidance in assisting the students in developing their interests, talents, skills and self-confidence. Activities offered include (but are not limited to): sports, games, arts and crafts, music, life skills and special events. Students also have time to complete their homework, as well as relax and socialize with friends.

What are the hours of YAS? YAS runs from the time that school dismisses until 6:15p.m.

What middle schools have the YAS program? YAS is offered at: Belmont Ridge MS, Blue Ridge MS*, Eagle Ridge MS, Farmwell Station MS, Harper Park MS*, Mercer MS, River Bend MS, Seneca Ridge MS and Smarts Mill MS. *The Principals from Harmony and Simpson support our program by providing transportation to the YAS program at Harper and Blue Ridge Middle.

How much does YAS Cost? YAS is \$50 per month. Please make all payments to County of Loudoun.

How can I pay by credit/debit card when I pre-register? You will need to come to our office with the completed paperwork to pay the \$50 September tuition with credit/debit cards. Our office is located at 20145 Ashbrook Pl., Suite 170 Ashburn, VA 20147

My child has a registration form on file with CASA or YAS, can we just fill out the addendum and send in the check for \$50? YAS will need a new complete registration form, addendum form and the Commonwealth of Virginia School Entrance form from everyone, including children with forms on file with YAS and CASA. This will ensure that all parent and emergency contact information is up to date. We greatly appreciate your help in making the YAS program as safe as possible for our students.

Can we use WebTrac to pay for YAS? Yes. However, the initial \$50 fee must be paid by check or in-person credit/debit. Families will then have the option of using WebTrac to make online payments beginning with the October payment due on September 1st, 2015.

Why does the YAS Registration Form ask for my email address? If you provide your email address on the Registration Form, we will email you to confirm that your registration for the 2015-2016 school year at YAS has been successful. Sending you an email instead of using traditional mail will allow you to get information faster and save taxpayer dollars.
