

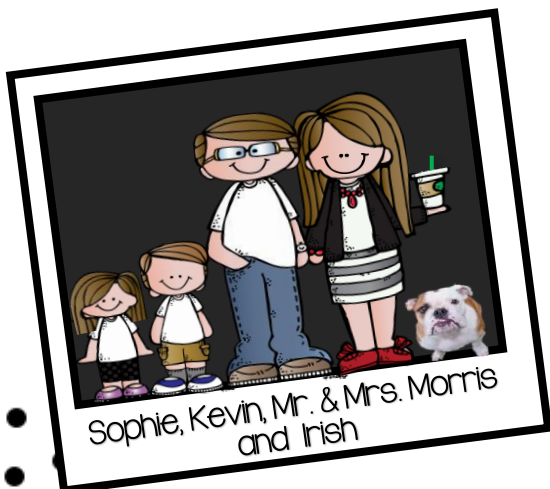
Welcome to Kindergarten
