HPMS Retake Policy

- If a student earns a 69 or below on a summative assessment (not projects), the student **MUST** retake the assessment until they earn a minimum grade of 70. Students in Fine Arts & CTE classes need to work with their teachers if they have questions about large graded projects.  
The teacher will staple the Retake Contract to the original assessment.  
This *teacher-driven* re-teach/retake process must take place within six days of receipt of the graded assessment.
- If a student earns a 70-79 on a summative assessment, the student **MAY** retake this assessment **ONCE**.  
The student must obtain a Retake Contract from the teacher and staple it to the original assessment.  
This *student-driven* review/retake process must take place within six days of receipt of the graded assessment.
- Students will receive the higher of the two grades up to a maximum of 80%.
