

Seniors, would you like to paint your parking space?

This year HHS seniors that purchase a parking permit will have the opportunity to paint/personalize their parking spaces for an additional \$25. The proceeds from this project will be used to support school and student needs throughout the school year. The process for this is simple:

- Purchase a parking permit. Permits will be on sale beginning Wednesday, July 24th for seniors. Students purchasing permits will need to complete a parking permit form (available in the main office or on the HHS website) and come to HHS during office hours (8:30—3:30 M-F) to select a parking space. Parking permits cost \$200/yr. or \$100/semester. Payments may be made in the main office or via the HHS website.
- Purchase a painting pass for \$25. Students purchasing painting passes will need to complete a painting pass form (available in the main office or on the HHS website) and submit a painting pass sketch for approval prior to painting. These payments may be made in the main office or via the HHS website and are a separate payment from a parking permit.
- Complete and submit a sketch of your parking space design—this sketch must be completed on the designated form and approved before painting may begin. All designs must be positive and school appropriate and the final product must match the approved design. HHS reserves the right to refuse any design that is deemed inappropriate.
- Come to the HHS student lot **on Saturday, July 27th from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. or Sunday, July 28th from 9 a.m.- 4 p.m.** with the following items:
 - A copy of both your signed painting pass and your approved painting design form.
 - Indoor/Outdoor water-based latex paint (no spray paint, fluorescent paint, reflective paint or oil-based paints of any kind will be allowed). Please note that the average parking space is approximately 162 square feet and that you will probably want to put down a “base coat” if your space has previously been painted—check your parking space before you buy paint!
 - A broom or leaf blower to sweep the parking space before you paint (be careful not to sweep onto another student’s wet paint!)
 - Chalk to sketch out your design before painting.
 - Masking tape or painter’s tape to mark off a 4 inch space around your spot and the parking spot number.
 - Brushes, rollers, paint trays, etc....
 - Trash bags to gather up all trash.
 - Friends and family to help you paint.
 - A ruler/yardstick/tape measure to help measure the design boundary.
 - Comfort items (pop up shade tent, food & drink, folding chairs, etc....) Our parking lot is HOT, especially in July/August, so plan accordingly.

Paint is expensive, so students are encouraged to share the cost w/ a friend or to recycle paint from another project. Lowe’s/Home Depot often sell paint that has been returned for much less than the original price—if you ask someone at the paint counter they can show you what they have.
