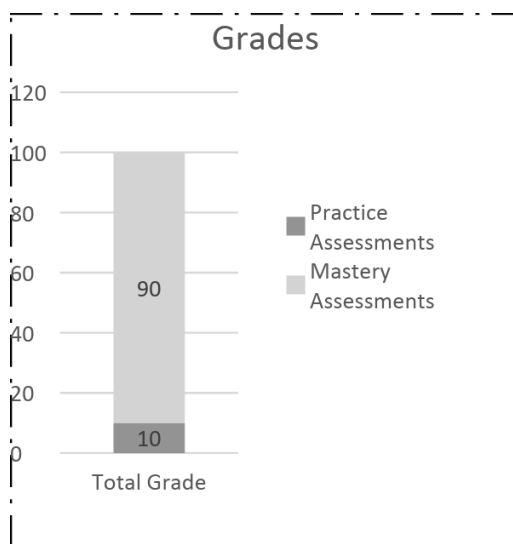
Practice/ Formative Assessments (10%)

- Small in class activities: will be done occasionally and if they are collected they will be formative.
- Homework: You will get homework every night. **All problems must be attempted to earn full credit.**
 - Daily Homework: Homework will be checked at the beginning of each block. Homework will be graded on a four-point scale based on completion and significant effort shown.

Mastery/ Summative Assessments (90%)

- Large Activities or Projects: point values will vary and due dates will be given in advance, but most of these activities will take several class periods.
- Quizzes: will be administered occasionally throughout a unit.
- Unit Tests: will be administered at the end of a unit and will vary in length and point value depending on the topic.
- Quarter/Semester Tests: will be cumulative and we will review and post dates well in advance.

Any other assignments throughout the year will have clear due dates, point values, and it will be stated whether they are formative or summative.
