First Slide: Name (first and last), grade level for next year, and **what class you wish to PLACE INTO:**

- Art 2
- Photo 1 (year class)
- Computer Graphics (year class)
- Draw/Paint (year class)
- Ceramics/Sculpture (semester electives - paired)

Artwork Slides: (10-20 pieces of artwork)

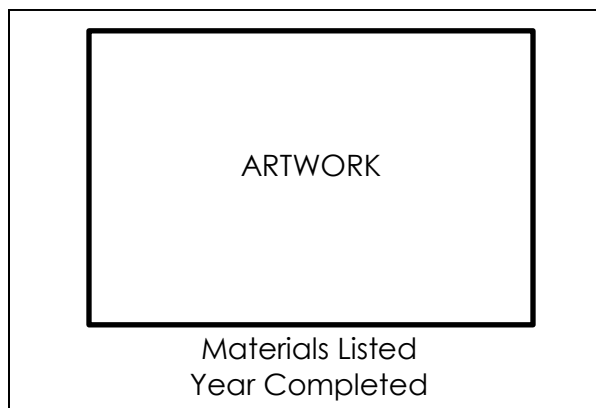
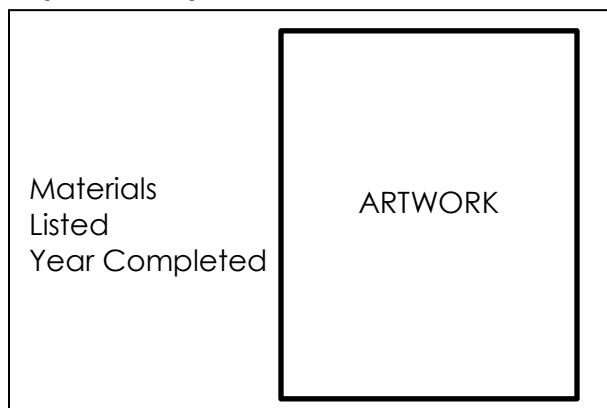
- Artwork should be sized as large as possible, make sure that you don't stretch your photos
- Indicate what materials you used to make your artwork and the year you finished the artwork
- Please note that you may use sketchbook drawings to fulfill some of these requirements

Artwork:

Your artwork should show a variety of skills including examples of **at least three different media** (Media is defined as the type of material you are using like graphite (pencil), pen, charcoal, watercolor, etc...)

- **Drawing/Painting: (3-6 artworks)**
 - Strong examples include:
 1. Observation (Drawing what you see in front of you, like simple objects and still lifes)
 2. Perspective (Linear Perspective like buildings and architecture going back in space)
 3. Portrait (Drawing the face according to proper proportion)
 4. Other Examples such as contour line and gesture drawing
- **Your Own Style/Interest: (3-5 artworks)**
 - Strong examples include:
 1. Work that is unique and original.
 2. Work that reflects individual thought, not copied images/characters from the internet.
 3. Work that has detail and includes depth created with value.
- **If possible, include examples from at least two different categories below: (4-10 images)**
 - Sculpture (Wire, Paper-Mache, Book Making, Clay...)
 - Painting (Acrylic, Watercolor, or Oil)
 - Mixed Media/Collage (Mixing multiple media together in one artwork)
 - Printmaking (linoleum, etching, monoprint, collagraph, ...)
