Dear Parents and Guardians:

We are pleased that your student has chosen to take an Advanced Placement (AP) course this year and want to assist you in planning for the AP exam, which will be administered in person, at school, May 1-12, 2023.

**Students must register for an AP test by Friday, November 4 at 5:00PM.** This can be done on the College Board's website at [AP Students | College Board](#). Requests received after that date may result in a \$40 late fee, per test. Students who register for a test but do not take it may be charged a \$40 unused test fee.

The AP exam administration schedule is included below and available [here](#). If your student attends the Academies of Loudoun and plans to register for an AP exam, please refer to the [Academies of Loudoun AP Exam Registration Guidance Document](#).

This year, College Board is offering an in-school digital AP Exam option in the following subjects:

- AP Computer Science Principles
- AP English Language and Composition
- AP English Literature and Composition
- AP European History
- AP Seminar
- AP United States History
- AP World History: Modern

The digital exams are full length, proctored exams, administered on the same day/time as corresponding paper exams. Students will have the option to decide which format they would like to take and will need to let their AP teacher know by Friday, November 4. Students must provide their own transportation to school on the day of testing. Morning exams begin at 7:45 AM and afternoon exams begin at 12:15 PM, with exams lasting about 4 hours. Students may not be dismissed from an exam until all students have finished testing, per College Board regulations. Please make every effort to schedule vacations, appointments, or other activities on dates that do not conflict with the test administration dates, as make-up testing is permitted for verified emergencies only.

Loudoun County Public Schools will pay for up to four AP tests, per enrolled student, for the duration of their high school tenure. After those four, students, parents, and/or guardians are responsible for all financial obligations, the exception being students who are eligible for free or reduced lunch. Each exam is \$88.00, except for AP Seminar and AP Research, which are \$136.00. Students are encouraged to contact their post-secondary institutions of interest to determine whether they [accept AP scores](#) for credit or course promotion.



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### **Additional ACL Information**

Students must decide if they would like to take the AP Test(s) by November 4, 2022. If you change a testing decision or testing location after November 4, 2022, you may be subject to the \$40 late fee. The Academies of Loudoun will offer ALL AP exams, regardless if the class is offered on site.

It is important to know that **transportation will not be provided** and that student parking passes will continue to be enforced due to limited onsite parking. Parents/guardians/students must provide their own transportation to the school if the test is scheduled for 7:45 AM and from the school if the test goes beyond 3:30 PM on the day of testing. The AP exam schedule is attached with the A-Day/B-Day schedule to assist with student AP Registration. We are **encouraging** Academies families to register to take their AP Exams at the location they are attending based on the A/B schedule as this will alleviate having two exams registered at different testing locations.

- May 1, 2023 (11:59 p.m. ET) is the deadline for:
  - AP Seminar and AP Research students to submit performance tasks as final and their presentations to be scored by their AP Seminar or AP Research teachers.
  - AP Computer Science Principles students to submit their Create performance task as final.

Occasionally, circumstances make it necessary for students to test late. To preserve the security of AP Exams, alternate forms are used for late testing. All students who are approved to participate in late testing at a given school must take these alternate exams on the scheduled late-testing dates at the scheduled times.
