Project Description:

This project provides funding to renovate and construct an estimated 38,000 square foot addition that will include a multipurpose room, five (5) classrooms, and other ancillary spaces. The multipurpose room will provide program space as a gymnasium and auditorium with associated storage and office space. The five-classroom addition will accommodate kindergarten classroom space; the project will also provide additional restrooms in the building. Renovation work will include the cafeteria, kitchen, and office areas. The project will also remove all modular classrooms from the school site.

Project Description


This project plans for the renovation of and addition to the historic Banneker Elementary School. The scope will include phased construction to maintain the current school operations throughout construction.

The building and site hold important historical significance in the community. LCPS aims to preserve and restore the exterior of the original building and to renovate the interior maintaining footprints of original classrooms. The addition will complement the original building and uphold its importance.

FEASIBILITY STUDY OCTOBER 7, 2022
