

**Proposed MS-14, Dulles North Middle School
CPAM-2020-0001, Public Facilities in Rural Policy Area**

Questions from the Community

- 1. If we are located in the Rural Policy Area, does that mean that the new school is intended for our neighborhood?**

Being in the Rural Policy Area does not automatically mean the school is intended for a particular neighborhood. The School Board sets the attendance zones for schools and typically establishes secondary school attendance zones 18 months prior to a school opening. The planned opening for MS-14 is fall 2024, which would provide for the attendance zone process in spring 2023.

- 2. Additionally, the notice mentioned additional schools being built. Is there a tentative timeline for when a new high school will be potentially built?**

The [School Board Adopted FY2021-FY2026 Capital Improvement Program](#) identifies a new high school in Dulles North (HS-14) with a planned opening for the 2028-2029 school year. The School Board has not designated a site for this school (HS-14).

- 3. Will the address of these new schools be Ashburn, Aldie, or Leesburg?**

The address in that general area is Leesburg. Addresses are determined by the Loudoun County Department of Mapping when a property is developed. There is currently no address for this site.
