Cellular Tower Proposal at Woodgrove High School

Milestone Towers is proposing a 165-foot tall telecommunications facility (lattice tower) at Woodgrove High School, located at 36811 Alder School Road in Purcellville. Loudoun County Public Safety and AT&T will be the first to locate on the proposed tower; there will be space for additional wireless providers.

The placement of the tower on a Loudoun County Public Schools (LCPS) site is guided by Loudoun County School Board Policy and Regulation 6350, Wireless Network Facility Colocation. In addition to Loudoun County School Board review, Milestone Towers must also obtain Loudoun County-required land use approvals and permits.

At the June 7, 2022 School Board meeting, LCPS staff will present the proposed site assessment as an information item; a public hearing specific to the cellular tower proposal will also be held on June 7, in advance of the information item review.
