

TUITION FEES

The Loudoun County School Board charges tuition for out-of-state and out-of-county students except as provided in Policy 8115 (persons who may be admitted free).

A. Out-of-State Students. The tuition cost for out-of-state students shall not exceed the total per capita cost of education, exclusive of capital outlay and debt service for Loudoun County Public Schools as referenced in the State Code of Virginia § 22.1-5.

B. Out-of-County Students. The tuition cost for out-of-county Virginia students admitted to Loudoun County Public Schools as provided in School Board Policy 8125, shall be based on the State calculation of local share of revenue divided by the adjusted average daily membership.

C. Data. Data required for this calculation shall be obtained from the notification of the school division's estimated average per pupil cost for public education for the coming school year in accordance with the budget estimates per Policy 4135.
