## ROOM PARENT/TEAM

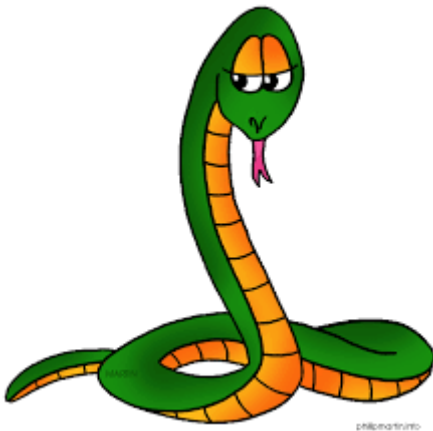
