Math 7

Welcome to 7th grade! Math 7 is designed to take the content you learned last year a step further, and to get you prepared to solve real world problems. Students are expected to participate in class activities and complete homework assignments on time. Class activities will include group work, independent work, games, stations, and more. Math 7 will require dedication and hard work in order to reach our goals.

GRADING:

We will use a total points system with two categories: tests and quizzes. Homework will be scored for completion and will be checked in class the period after it was assigned. Incomplete homework will be recorded as a 0, a late homework score will be noted in the comment section. In terms of summative grades, each unit will consist of quizzes and a test. Any quiz grade below an 80% will require quiz corrections. All quiz corrections must be completed prior to the unit test. Students will then be given a chance to replace quiz grades with the unit test grade, providing all homework, classwork, and corrections/signature have been completed on time. **Unit tests will not be retested.**

QUIZZES & GRADE REPLACEMENT:

- Quizzes will be given throughout the unit to check for understanding
- If a student receives below a B (79% or less) on a quiz, they will be required to complete quiz corrections in class and/or at home

TESTS:

Tests will be given at the end of each unit, they will not be retested. However, quiz grades may be replaced with the test grade provided all homework, classwork, and corrections/signature were completed prior to the test day.

MAKE-UP WORK:

The LCPS policy allows one day for each day absent. If you anticipate an absence, please see your teacher in advance to get work needed for that day. Do not fall behind. Please check Google Classroom and our website for daily information. YOU will be responsible for making up any missed work. We will attempt to remind you of the missing work and help you get caught up, but essentially it is YOUR responsibility. Please schedule a time to take make-up tests and quizzes during resource or before/after school.

MATERIALS:

Students should come to every class with their agenda, binder, pencil, dry erase marker, and headphones.

AGENDAS:

You are required to record homework assignments and upcoming quiz/test dates in your agenda. This information can also be found in Google Classroom, class website, and Parent/Student Vue.

BRING YOUR TECHNOLOGY:

We will be using technology frequently throughout the year. It is expected that you have your Chromebook charged and with you every day in class. During instruction, devices are expected to be face down/closed and silenced.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM:

We will be using Google Classroom for our class this year. Google Classroom is an online classroom where students will complete assignments both in class and at home. Students will be using Google Classroom EVERY CLASS DAY. If students do not have access to a computer with internet at home, they should complete assignments in the computer lab during open lab time or in the library during their resource block. Google Classroom assignments are mandatory and students will be required to complete late assignments during working lunch. Parents should check ParentVUE for missing assignments throughout the quarter.
