4. **Information Items**

4.01 Beginning of the School Year Update: Jeannie Kloman shared Student Health Services is in the process of screening kindergarten, third, seventh, tenth grades for vision and hearing. Student Health has partnered with Shenandoah University, Northern Virginia Community College, and George Washington University to support nursing students. Nursing students at these institutions will complete their practicum in LCPS schools.

4.02 Concussion Regulation 8445: "Concussion in Student and Student-Athletes" were approved by the School Board last year. Student Health Services staff are updating the Regulations to align with the approved policy. The School Board does not need to approve the regulations. The regulations are in Board Docs.

4.03 Policy 8420: Reviewed by SHAB. The policy reflects that Naloxone (Narcan) can be stocked by LCPS and administered.

4.04 SHAB survey recommendations. SHAB was sent a brief survey over the summer by Student Health Services and Office of Student Services. Dr. Bowers reviewed the data and recommended that any future surveys be submitted earlier in the school year.

4.05 Annual Report: The draft annual report was reviewed. Suggestions from the Board included emailing meeting minutes after each meeting; have a parent representative from elementary, middle and high school; request committee members email items to add to the agenda, post agenda and minutes to the website.

4.06 Draft Bylaws review: Committee reviewed bylaws and provided input. Office of Student Services will check with legal team to determine if the bylaws can be passed by majority vote or must be approved by the School Board.
