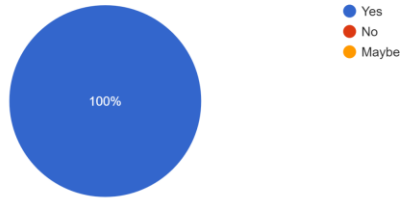

# FY24 SHAB Survey Results \*

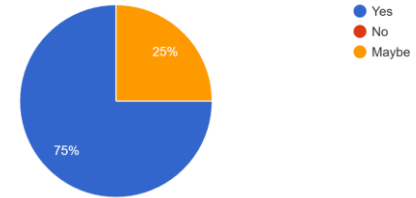
Expand School Nurses to all elementary schools.

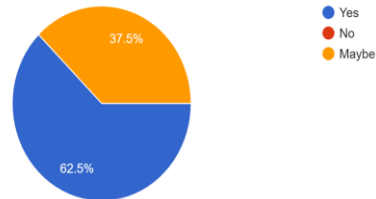
Support higher wages for School Nurses.

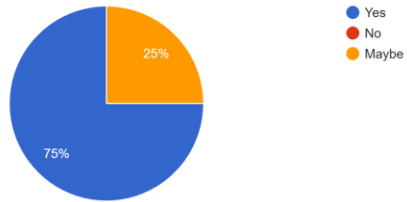

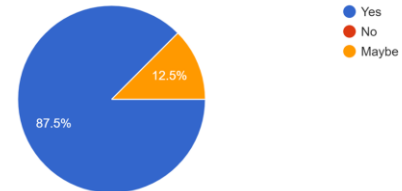

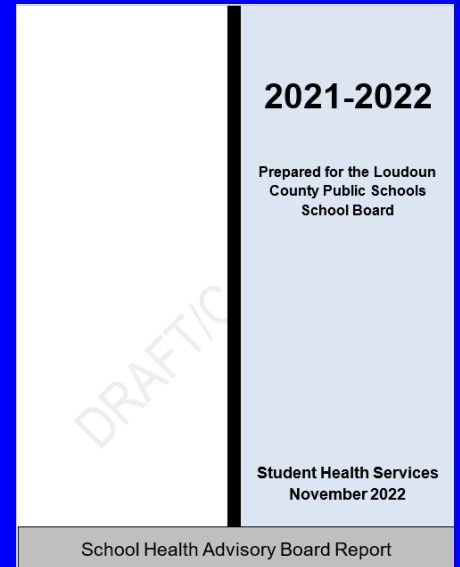
