 MackinVIA (SRM)	Seneca's ebook and audiobook catalog	3 books can be checked out at a time for 2 weeks. Books can also be put on hold. Multi-user means an unlimited number of people can check the book out at the same time.
 PebbleGo (Secondary)	General Encyclopedia. Very visual and lower level/introductory. Also in Spanish and can be automatically read aloud	Has short video clips
 ProQuest CultureGrams (SRM)	Both United States and World encyclopedia. Lots of great information like recipes, sports, history & interviews with people	A lot of fun information. Check out Kid's View to see what life is like in different countries. Will read out loud and can translate
 Safari Montage	Has a lot of different educational videos, and movies. Searchable by keyword	Can assign entire videos, or just a chapter to Google Classroom
 TumbleBook Cloud - Middle	Online ebooks and audiobooks & videos from National Geographic	Enhanced ebooks will read out loud, while highlighting the word. Sometimes the words highlighted lag behind the reading.
 TumbleBook Library - Middle	Large amount of graphic novels. You can also choose books that are in Spanish or French. Story books are like videos, and are fun to watch	We also have Tumblebooks Jr and Elementary, that has access to younger books
 World Book Online	Encyclopedia - Student version is a good overall place to start. Students doing research can have the content read to them.	Check under menu (upper right corner) for <a href="#">various quizzes</a> on different content, as well as timelines and other information
