## Step One

#### PAY \$25 FEE


Pay online, or bring cash or check with you to one of the painting days. **PLEASE NOTE: Buying online does not reserve your spot**– spots will only be reserved on a first-come, first served-basis at school on one of the designated painting dates, with the approved application. \*\*Reserving a spot indicates that you will be purchasing your parking spot from the county when/if parking goes on sale second semester.\*\*



# **Step Two**

#### GET YOUR DESIGN APPROVED

Fill in the attached form and bring the form to one of the designated painting times. You must use the attached template for your design. Your design must be done in color/include the colors and must represent exactly what will be painted on your parking space if it is accepted. Your design must be approved BEFORE painting. Once your design is approved, you will be able to pick your spot and begin painting.



# Step Three

# GET YOUR SUPPLIES READY

Bring your own own outdoor acrylic/latex outdoor paint and brushes/rollers. **No spray paint**. You should also bring painters tape to mark off a four-inch border around the lines and spot number. Other supplies could include a broom, a tent, water, sunscreen, snacks, drop cloth, and chalk to outline your design.



#### **Step Four**

### PICK YOUR SPOT & PAINT

On the designated painting day, check in at the SCA table and get your design approved by Ms. Menna. You must have paid online or have your \$25 with you. Once your design is approved, you can choose your spot.

**Spots will be chosen on a first-come, first-served basis.** Once you've chosen your spot, you can start panting!

#### PAINT DURING DESIGNATED TIMES

Once your design is approved, you can paint your spot during any of the designated times below:
