



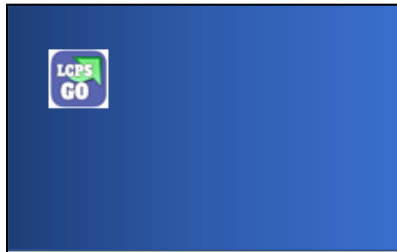

## LCPS Student Opportunities Application

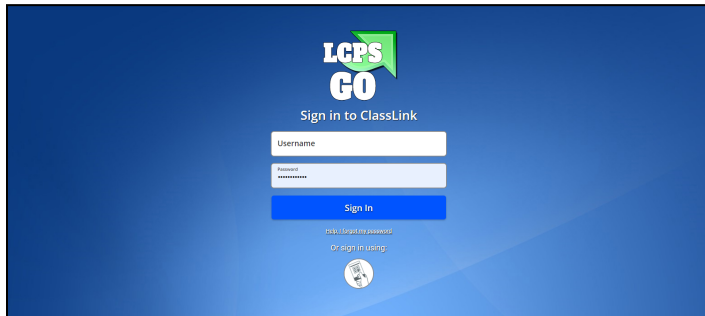
The LCPS Student Opportunities application is used to provide access to LCPS Student Programs. This application is accessible from LCPS GO.

### Log into the LCPS Student Opportunities Application

1. From your desktop, double-click to display the LCPS GO application launchpad or access <http://go.lcps.org> from your Internet browser (Chrome browser recommended for best experience).



2. If prompted to sign in, enter your username and password and click Sign In.



3. The LCPS GO application launchpad is displayed. Select the Student Opportunities icon.

- Language Assessment Reporting System (LARS)**  
LCPS allows students, with the ability to comprehend and communicate in languages other than English, to earn high school credits through State-approved world language assessments. The Credit Through Testing (CTT) exam measures students' language proficiency in order to award one, two, or three world language credits. CTT exams are offered each November and registration is through the Language Assessment Reporting System (LARS).
