

Calculating Your Final Course Grade and How You Can Possibly Improve It

Woodgrove High School – May 14, 2020

The LCPS Department of Instruction has detailed the process for calculating final course grades for 2019-2020 and provided an opportunity for students to improve that grade if they would like. This sheet highlights this process.

In order to calculate your final course grade, you need the following grades which can be found in the Grade Book part of StudentVUE and ParentVUE:

- MP1 = Marking Period 1 numeric grade
- MP2 = Marking Period 2 numeric grade
- S1 = Semester 1 numeric average
- MP3 = Marking Period 3 numeric grade

The highest of these three scenarios will be automatically chosen by LCPS as the student’s final course grade. Decimals that are .5 or higher round up.

Scenario 1	Scenario 2	Scenario 3	Semester-Two Classes Only
$\frac{MP1 + MP2 + MP3}{3} = \text{Final Grade}$	$\frac{S1 + MP3}{2} = \text{Final Grade}$	S1 = Final Grade	MP3 = Final Grade

Families that would like to convert any Final Grade between a D- and an A+ into a P (Pass) may do so using a Permission Click form that will be available closer to the end of the school year.

An opportunity exists for Final Grades to be adjusted based on evidence gathered from student work during the fourth quarter.

87 and 89 (B+)	90 or higher	A-
90 and 92 (A-)	93 or higher	A
93 and 97 (A)	98 or higher	A+
98 and 100 (A+)	---	A+
