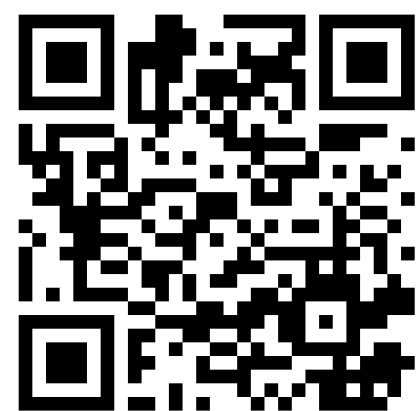

# School Health

Immunizations (vaccines) are required to attend school in the United States

The School Nurse, Social Worker, Psychologist, or Counselor can provide you with a list of doctors and dentists

Medication may be taken at school with proper documentation from a doctor or a parent.

Parents must take the medication and note in to the office. Students may not bring medication in.

Only the School Nurse or assigned designee can give the medication to the student (including cough drops and any over-the-counter meds)



# Important!

If a student has a fever of 100 degrees or higher they must go home.

Students must be fever-free for 24 hours without medicine before coming back.

Students may also be sent home for vomiting.

Wearing of masks is now optional in all LCPS buildings.

**How has my student progressed over the school year so far?**

**What is my student like in class?**

**What are specific strategies that I can use at home to help advance my student based on his/her growth areas?**

**Can I see a few examples of my student's work in class?**

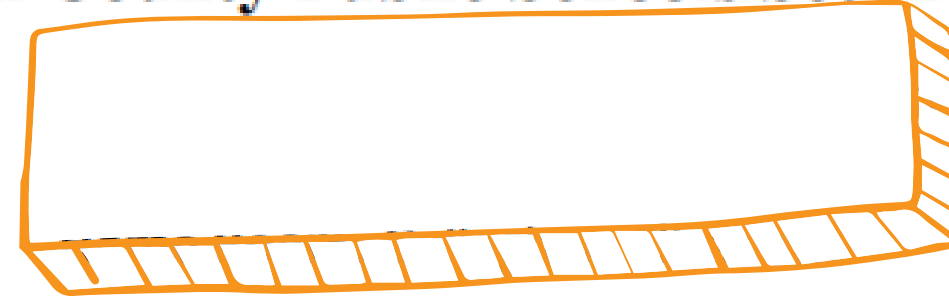
