35th Anniversary of the 1984 Baseball Team






- •Only 1 senior on the team

35th Anniversary Joe Lightfoot Wrestling






- Wrestling Individual District Champion in 82, 83 and 84

30th Anniversary of the 1989 Softball Team






- •Played home games on the baseball field and practiced on the current field
