40th Anniversary of the 880 Yard Relay Team



- Katy Clark ran the 440 M, Diane Lind Petrella and Jan Ullman Richardson ran the 110 M and Shari Higgs ran the 220 M
- Finished 4th in the District
- First Regional and State Champions for PVHS in 1977
- Currently holds PVHS record for 880 yd. relay- 1:51.4
- The girls worked on their handoffs at least 15 minutes each practice and enjoyed being on a relay team.
- When runners compete on a relay team another dynamic comes into play: wanting to turn in your best race for “for the success of the group.”

35th Anniversary of the 1982 Gymnastics Team

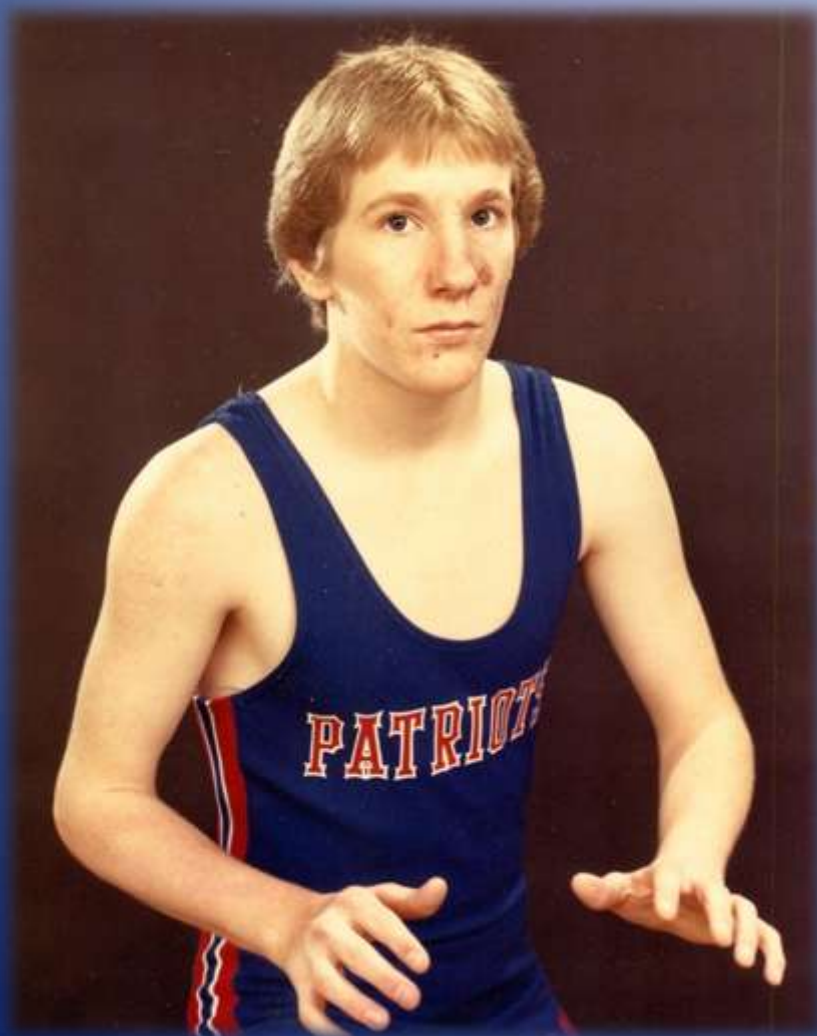


- District Champions

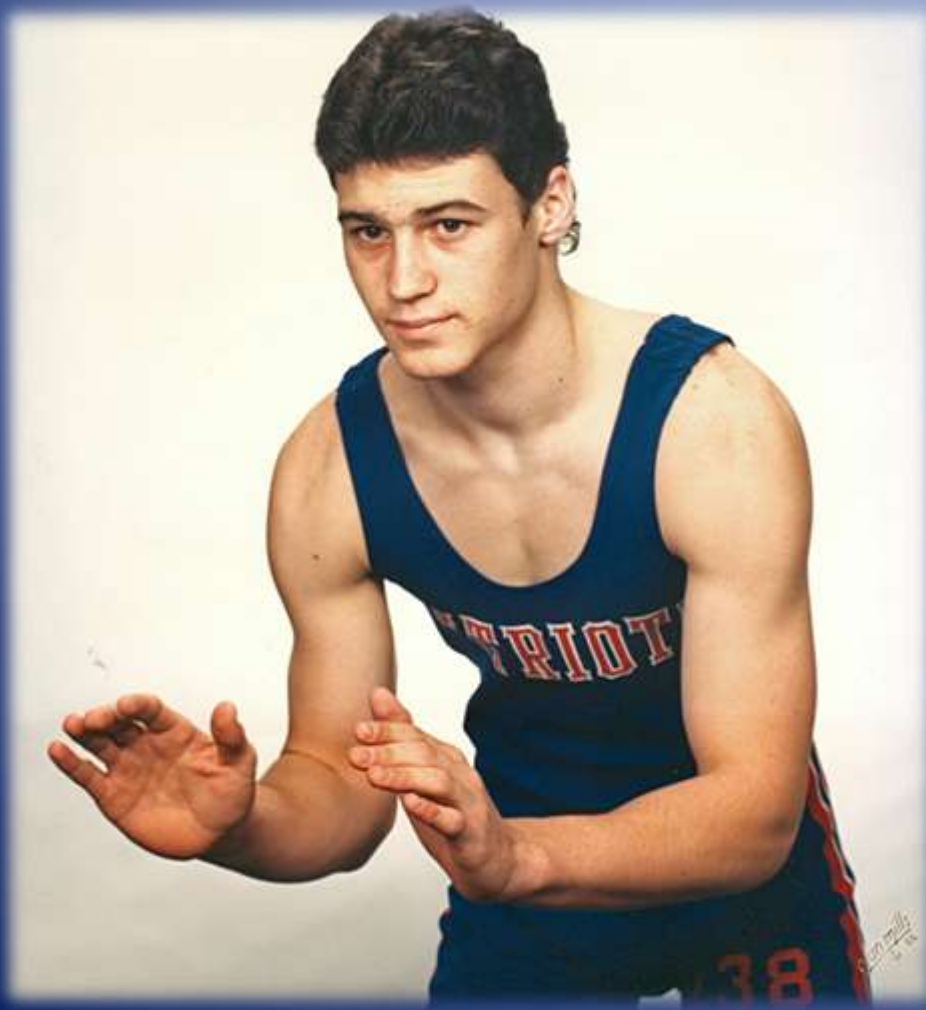
35th Anniversary Scott McGowan Wrestling

- Competed in 100 M Hurdles, 100 M and 400 yd relay team at Penn State
- Was named Women's 1st Team All Big Ten
- Currently in the All Time Top 10 for 100 M Hurdles at Penn State
