How to Use the PSAT Score Matching Tool in your College Board Account

Please follow these instructions to match up your PSAT score report with your College Board account:

Step 1: Log into your College Board account at <u>studentscores.collegeboard.org</u> (You need to create a College Board account if you don't already have one by clicking on the "Create Account" link on the login page.)

Step 2: Click on the "Matching Tool" link within your College Board account.

Step 3: Review your College Board account information to make sure it is correct. If any of your information needs to be edited, click the "**Update My Info**" button. Below is a screenshot of the information you will review.

Step 4: Once you have edited and verified your account information, you will click the button "**Get My Scores**". From here, you will provide information to help match your scores to your account.

Supply Test Information:
