

## Scholarships that do NOT require US Citizenship or Residency

### **TheDream.US Scholarship Program**

Amount: The maximum award is \$12,500 for an associate's degree and up to \$25,000 for a bachelor's degree. Students must attend a partner school, such as NOVA. **This scholarship is only available for students who have DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals) or TPS (Temporary Protected Status).**

**Herb Block Foundation** - The Herb Block Scholarship provides financial assistance to students of all ages to attend community colleges in the DC metro area. It helps about 100 students each year gain access to higher education they could not otherwise afford. This scholarship is available for DACA students.

Deadlines: June 15 for the upcoming fall semester;

November 10 for the upcoming spring semester

Amount: up to \$8,000 per year

Amount: \$5,000 - \$15,000

**Chin: Shui Kuen and Allen Chin Scholarship** – Must be an incoming freshman or current full-time undergraduate student at a four-year college, be currently or formerly employed at an Asian-owned or Asia cuisine restaurant (or have a parent who is employed in such a restaurant), demonstrate community advocacy on behalf of Asian Americans, immigrant, gay and lesbian and/or other progressive cause, have a 3.0 GPA and have financial need.
