Art (All 6th graders take this class)

- ✘ Sketchbook – Unlined pages, any size but recommend 8.5 x 11, spiral or hardbound binding preferred or 1 folder filled with unlined paper
- ✘ 1 package #2 pencils, 24 pack
- ✘ A "big eraser" – like your standard Pink Pearl or anything other than a pencil top
- ✘ Sharpie – or other black permanent, waterproof marker – one fine point, one extra- or ultra-fine point

All Music Classes

Band

All grades & all instruments:

- ✎ Quality band instrument and necessary accessories (please contact Ms. Eastridge or Mr. Marciano before making an online instrument purchase)
- ✎ Optional: music stand for home practice

6th Grade:

- ✎ *Do It!* By James O Froseth – Please buy the book that corresponds with your child's instrument

7th Grade & 8th Grade:

Necessary accessories for each instrument:

Flute: cleaning rod and thin handkerchief or silk cloth

Oboe: at least 3 medium-soft reeds or medium-hard (check with your teacher) – Emerald brand, swab, cork grease

Clarinet: swab, cork grease, at least six (6) clarinet reeds – Vandoren brand (strength 2.5 or 3), Juno brand (strength 3), or D'Addario brand (strength 2.5 or 3), reed case (not the plastic holders that come with reeds – these are not good for used reeds)

Alto Saxophone: neck strap, swab, cork grease, at least six (6) alto saxophone reeds – Vandoren brand (strength 2.5) or D'Addario brand (strength 2.5), reed case (not the plastic holders that come with reeds – these are not good for used reeds)

Baritone, Horn, Trumpet, & Tuba: valve oil, slide grease

Trombone: Slide oil and slide grease (these are different)

Percussion: Bell kit, practice pad, drum sticks (Vic Firth, Promark, or Ludwig brand – size 5A), bell (hard plastic) mallets, yarn mallets, stick bag

School Owned Instruments: Students playing the baritone or tuba will be able to rent their instruments through RBMS. This instrument stays at home for practice. Rental paperwork will be passed out the first week of school. Once the fee and paperwork are collected, the student will be able to take the instrument home. Mouthpieces are included with school-owned rentals. If you need an instruction for Summer Band Academy, please contact Ms. Eastridge or Mr. Marciano.
