Course: Easy Rotary Cut Quilt

Required Materials:

Double Irish Chain Rotary Cut Lap Quilt

Learn to piece a beginner's level, rotary cut "Double Irish Chain" lap size quilt. You will learn how to rotary cut fabric, piece and do all steps from A to Z to complete quilt. The quilt will be tied to anchor layers together. A good class for a beginner or someone wanting to refresh skills. Home sewing machine needed.

SUPPLY LIST

Double Irish Chain Rotary Cut Quilt

- Fabric 1 for first color square: 2 yards
- Fabric 2 for second color square: 1 1/4 yards
- Background Fabric (high contrast to above 2 fabrics): 2 1/2 yards
- Border Fabric 3 1/4 yards
- Binding 3/4 yards
- Backing 4 yards
- large all purpose (not quilting thread) thread such as Guterman's or Molyneux - try to avoid cheap
- sewing pins
- seam ripper - they dull over time, if needed, get a new one
- large quilting safety pins about 50-100
- pearl cotton - we will discuss in class - buy later
- masking tape for the end of class
- batting - twin size-extra loft thickness unless you want to machine/hand quilt
- Medium Size Rotary Cutter
- Medium Size Rotary cutter mat
- Rotary Cut Ruler 5-6" wide and 24" long

You need 100% cotton calico type fabric (44-45" wide). The fabric should be an all over pattern without direction. Google Double Irish Chain, then click images. We are doing a two color chain.

Check all fabric for colorfastness. Soak each fabric in a bucket of cold water. Wait one hour and then check water for bleeding. If water turns color, wring out fabric and start again. If after 2-3 soakings, you still have color in water, return fabric for refund. If no color in water, wash and dry
