2. Brushes: 5 Acrylic, Flat various sized from point to $\frac{3}{4}$ inch.

3. 12" x 16" canvas pad

4. Paper plate or palette pad

5. Plastic cup or water container

6. Paper towels

7. Optional: 16" x 20" canvas
