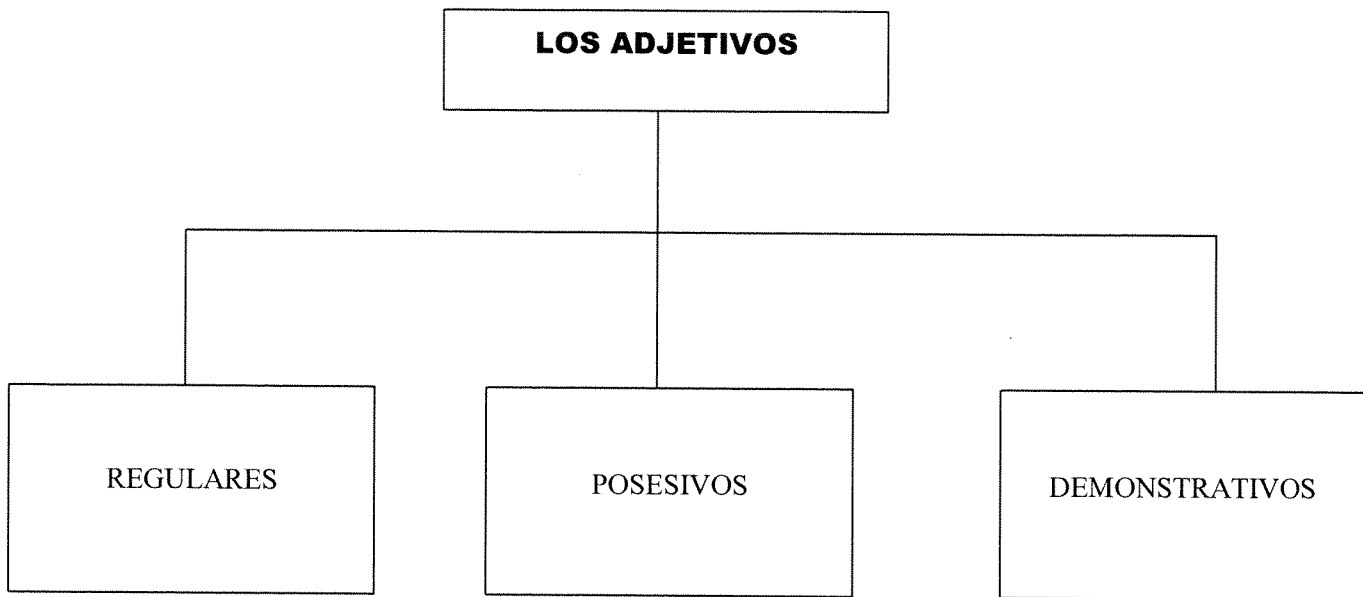


## Los adjetivos demostrativos

Adjectives branch out on the same "tree."



1. "Regular" adjectives describe nouns.

They agree in number and gender with the noun that they describe.

2. Possessive adjectives show <sup>(ownership)</sup> possession and relationship

They agree in number ONLY with the noun.

\*\*Possessive adjectives agree with the Object not the subject.

*\*Nuestro/a and vuestro/a MUST agree in # and gender.*

3. Demonstrative adjectives point to nouns.

They agree in number and gender with the noun they describe.

\*\*Demonstrative adjectives answer the question "Which one?"\*\*

"Close up" demonstrative adjectives are

SINGULAR

PLURALES

este	estos
esta	estas

"This"

"These"

"Far away" demonstrative adjectives are

SINGULAR

PLURALES

ese	esos
esa	esas

"That"

"Those"

This and These have the "t's".  
That and Those don't!

2. Prefiero llevar estos pantalones cortos.
3. Pensamos llevar esos vestidos bonitos.
4. ¿Prefieres llevar estos calcetines?
5. Ella prefiere llevar esas botas.
