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2. Textbook Scavenger Hunt- Based on your individual BIG QUESTION, locate **3 different forms of literature in our textbook** that are **somewhat related** to your question [short story, poem, essay, article, excerpt from a novel, or play]. Identify the title, the author, and the page number. Briefly explain how this particular piece of literature is somehow related to your BIG QUESTION (paragraph format).

3. Locate a **movie or song** that is somewhat related to your BIG QUESTION. How are the **events in the movie** related to the question itself, how you could possibly answer the question using components of this movie? Identify how the **lyrics of this particular song** are somehow related to your BIG QUESTION? Again, are the lyrics somehow able to help you answer the question, or are they simply related to certain aspects of the topic you are studying?

4. **Let's try to answer your question so far...** What is the answer to your question? Is this question a difficult one to answer? Has your idea about this topic changed since you started?

5. **Create a collage of pictures** / art / drawing, etc. Explain how these pictures / drawings are related to

your question [typing paper, glue, computer graphics,  
colored pencils, etc.]
