

Romeo and Juliet Final Activity

Directions: Use the provided paper to **create a graphic organizer** that could be used to improve student comprehension as students read/study *Romeo & Juliet*.

Be sure your graphic organizer is neat, accurate, and creative! Good Luck & happy creating!!

1. Identify key/**main characters** found within the play. Explain their connection to each other (how are they connected?) Write their names & their connection.
2. Identify **4 major conflicts** found within the play (a) type of conflict (b) who/what is involved in the conflict (c) how is the conflict resolved/ended (outcome).
3. Identify **4 significant cause & effect** relationships within the play (a) who/what involved (b) What happens first? (c) What happens because of this event? (d) How does it impact the play/plot?
4. FOIL: foil is a character whose values differ from those of the protagonist. The foil's differences highlight their key qualities of the main character. **Identify 2** examples of **FOIL** within the play from the following options (a) Rosaline/Juliet (b) Paris/Romeo (c) Benvolio/Tybalt (d) Mercutio/Romeo (e) The Nurse/Juliet's Mom (f) Benvolio/Romeo
5. Tragic flaw: Explain what **Romeo's character flaw** is (character trait).
6. **Who is to blame for the deaths** of Romeo/Juliet/Tybalt? (all 3).
7. **Summarize** the play in **8 sentences ONLY!!**
8. Family Feud... **Match** the following characters to either the **Montague** family or the **Capulet** family:

Tybalt, Romeo, Juliet, Lord Montague, Mercutio, Nurse, Count Paris, Friar Lawrence, Prince Escalus, Lady Capulet, Lady Montague, Rosaline, Lord Capulet

9. If you had to pick a color to represent 1 character from the play, **what color?**
10. What **theme song** would you suggest for this character?

Writing Sample: Read "Song Lyrics", by Stephen Sondheim on page 1108. **Write a paragraph** in which you make a connection between the song and what happened in the play.
