

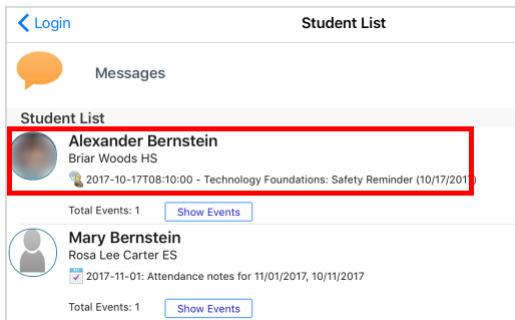

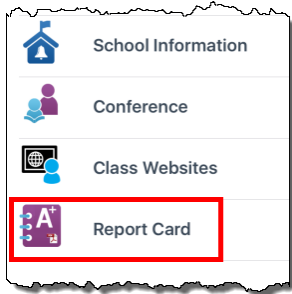
PARENTVUE APP - SECONDARY

If your child's school has not yet posted a PDF report card, please use the ParentVUE web version to view marking period report card grades.

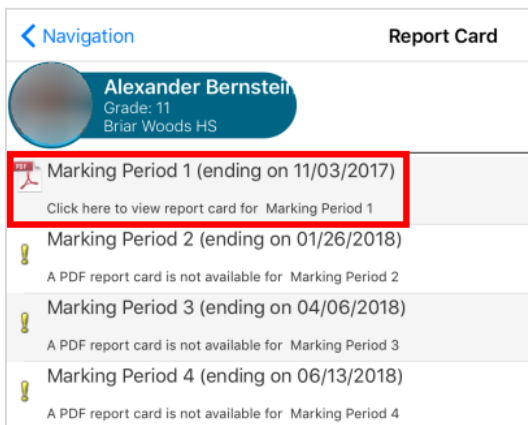
1. Open and log in to the ParentVUE app.

4. Tap the Marking Period that contains the report card PDF.

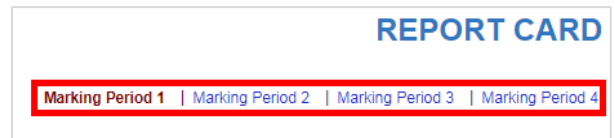
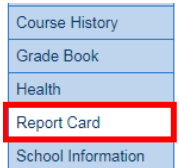

1. Log into your ParentVUE account at <https://portal.lcps.org>.
2. Click on the **Report Card** menu item at the left.
3. Select the marking period from the options at the top.

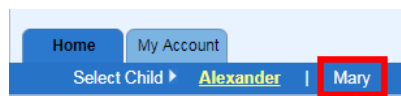


4. Click on the link labeled **Click here to view report card for Marking Period...**

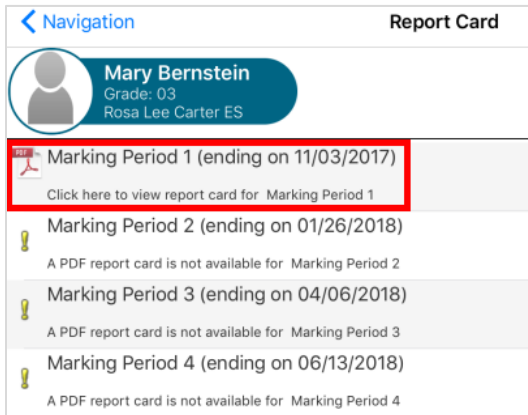
1. Open and log in to the ParentVUE app.

4. Tap the Marking Period that contains the report card PDF.

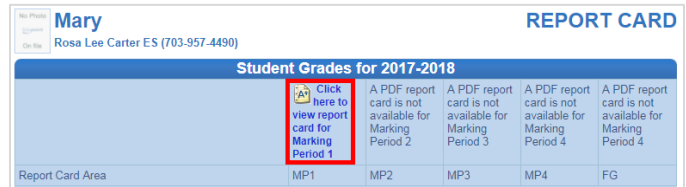
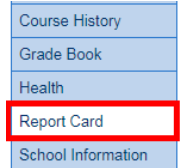

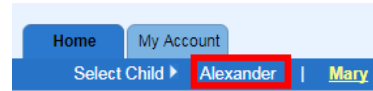
