Residents of any age, income, or background who need financial assistance may contact the Salvation Army of Loudoun County for help and advice. While food and meals are offered, programs also offer help for paying utility bills, rent, prescriptions, groceries, clothing, and furniture. There are also Christmas toys for kids and holiday meals.

A caseworker will sit down and meet the individual who needs help. They will then determine a client's eligibility for food or financial assistance based on need. The Salvation Army thrift stores provide free or low-cost household items, furniture, and clothing at a low-cost rate. A food bank is also on site, and holiday assistance is offered too.
