

STUDENT ARRIVAL

TRAFFIC PATTERN - ARRIVAL




- Walkers will enter through the Main Entrance doors (A2).
- **Bus Riders and Van** Riders will arrive in the Bus Loop and enter through the Main Entrance doors (A2).
- **Car Riders** will follow the traffic loop around the school parking lot and drop off their student/s on the sidewalk next to the gym doors. Cars are not permitted in the bus loop during arrival and dismissal.

School begins promptly at 8:00 a.m.

Students arriving after this time will need to be escorted by a responsible adult to the Main Entrance doors (A2) and ring the buzzer

STUDENT DISMISSAL

TRAFFIC PATTERN - DISMISSAL




- **KG Walkers** will be dismissed at the outside KG doors around the back of the school (C2, C3 or C4).
- Walkers whose classrooms are in the back hallway will be dismissed at Door B2 (left side of the building back by the playground).
- Walkers whose classrooms are in the front hallway will be dismissed at Door B3 (left side of the building towards the front of the school).
- Bus Riders and Van Riders will be dismissed through the Main Entrance doors (A2).
- **Car Riders** will be dismissed from the Gym Door (D8) in order of the parent's arrival in carline.
 - ✓ Place a sheet of paper on the passenger side of your front window that includes your student's <u>3-digit dismissal code</u>.
 - ✓ Your student/s will enter and exit the vehicle on the sidewalk side.
 - ✓ Parents should not exit the vehicle at any time. Staff is on-site to assist as needed.
 - ✓ Move slowly and be aware of those around you.
 - ✓ Follow the arrows shown in the Traffic Pattern Map.
 - ✓ Do not pass other cars in the loop.
 - ✓ Always follow staff directions.

SAFETY REMINDERS

Safety Reminders

- ➤ If you have authorized someone other than a parent/guardian to pick up your student from school, you must notify the front office through ParentVue, or send in a signed note with your child. That individual will need to show ID upon pick up.
- ➤ Cars are not allowed in the Bus Loop between 7:30—8:30 a.m. and 2:00-3:15 p.m. The Bus Loop must be free of traffic to allow LCPS school buses and daycare vans to safely maneuver while loading and unloading students.
- ➤ Always use sidewalks and crosswalks when walking to and from school. Adults and students are not permitted to walk over the hill and across the bus loop at any time.
- ➤ When dropping off or picking up students in Car Line, please follow the arrows shown in the traffic pattern map. Do not pass the car in front of you at any time and follow all staff directions.




ATTENDANCE

Daily attendance is taken at the beginning of the school day. Students who are not present in the classroom will be marked absent for the day. If a student arrives after 8:00 A.M. his/her attendance will be updated to tardy for the day.

LEAVING EARLY?

If your child needs to change their method of transportation home from school <u>or</u> will be picked up early, this information must be entered in ParentVue by clicking the blue button "Report Attendance" located to the right of your student's photo, select "Report Dismissal" and type a note providing details.

Changes of dismissal must be made by 2:00 p.m.

NOTICE: TITAN Family Portal has relaunched as LINQ Connect!

The Linq Connect payment system allows students/families to put money on an account to purchase school meals or other food items in our school cafeterias.

- <u>If you are a new family to LCPS</u>, you will need to register LINQConnect.com
- If you are a returning family and were registered with the Titan Family Portal, you will just need to download the Linq Connect App and sign in using the email address and password you previously used with Titan. Once you attach your student/s, any remaining balance from last year will appear next to your student's photo ID.

Student Issued Chromebooks

All students in LCPS are assigned an Individual Learning Device.

This device will remain with your child while they are enrolled as a student in LCPS. Don't forget to sign the Device Usage Agreement (available in ParentVUE) within 10 days of receiving your device.

Please note: Intentional damage or lost accessories (i.e., charging cable) will NOT be replaced by LCPS and may result in charges. A link with instructions on purchasing a replacement charging cable is on our website.

Student Logins

- **Grades K-2:** Students may use their <u>QuickCard</u> that allows for easy login OR may login manually using their student ID number (lunch number) and birthday (MMDD) Need to <u>print a new QuickCard</u>? You can do so from your child's LCPSGo account!
- <u>Grades 3-5:</u> Students will login manually using their student ID number (lunch number) and the "strong password" they will set at school
- <u>Password issues:</u> During school hours, students may request help from Mr. Saravia, our Digital Experience Specialist. Outside of school hours, a parent must call the Technology Support Center at 571-252-2112, open Monday through Friday 7:30 AM-5:00 PM.

Hardware Repairs

If a student Chromebook is in need of repair, the student may visit our school's Digital Experience Specialist (DES), Mr. Saravia, while they are in the building. If the device needs to be sent out for repairs, students will be assigned a loaner device until theirs has been fixed.

Best Practices

- On regular school days, we recommend developing a plan at home to ensure your child's device is charged and ready to go for the next school day. (Kindergarten students may leave their devices at school to charge)
- As a reminder, student Chromebooks are intended for schoolwork only.
- Take care of your device by keeping it out of the sun, keeping food/drinks away from it, and always carrying it with two hands.

NOTE: Students will not be assigned a loaner if they forget their device at home, unless a Chromebook is required for an assessment.

WHAT IS SCHOOLOGY?

Schoology is our online learning management system that offers a variety of tools students will utilize regularly. Students will be able to access assignments and other learning resources posted by their classroom teacher.

Parents can use the system to follow student progress, and preview student work.

Inclement Weather



When Loudoun County Public Schools experiences inclement weather conditions, the safety of our students and staff is the most important consideration.

The Public Information Office will announce school closures via telephone number of record of the parent or legal guardian.

School closures will be posted on the LCPS website and will be broadcast on local television news channels.

Decision-Making Process

The Loudoun County Public Schools (LCPS) Superintendent, or designee, will determine when schools and administrative offices observe a delayed opening, closing or early release in emergency situations, based upon the recommendation from the Assistant Superintendent for Support Services.
