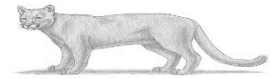

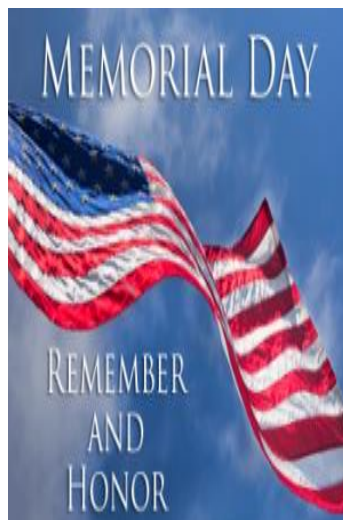
Volunteers in charge of water stations will get wet, so please dress accordingly. We also recommend sunscreen, hat, sunglasses and a refillable water bottle.

Watch a recording of the April 10, 2018 meeting by the link below. Holly Sears & Jeanine Edwards of NWEA explained how MAP tests work for Loudoun County students. Highlights include:

- Parents can get detailed reports of their student's progress including areas for improvement (parents must ask for the student profile shown below as your schools won't give these to you unless you ask for them - tomorrow, we will post a sample FOIA request to assist parents in obtaining these reports)

- For the cost of 1 hr of instructional time (~\$11/year), students and parents get accurate, nationally-normed competency scores while education administrators get data that can be used to evaluate curriculum and instructional effectiveness

- Parents can use the MAP scores on Khan Academy over the summer (or anytime) to obtain individualized, recommended exercises for their student to prevent summer lag.
