The SEARCH program is offered to all K-3 grade students and focuses on thinking skills. SEARCH teachers regularly visit the students' classrooms with activities designed to practice problem solving strategies, provide opportunities for students to use higher level thinking skills, and to identify students with exceptional ability. The FUTURA program is offered to 4th and 5th grade students who have completed the LCPS Gifted Eligibility process.

This is my twentieth year as a Gifted Resource Teacher. Before becoming a resource teacher, I taught second, third, fourth, and fifth grades.

As a Gifted Resource Teacher, I have the unique opportunity to work with students over multiple years and really see their thinking grow. This really is the most exciting aspect of my position.
