## Gingerbread Play Dough

1 cup all purpose flour  
1/2 cup salt  
2 tsp. cream of tartar  
1 tbsp. ground cinnamon  
2 tsp. ground ginger  
1 tsp. ground nutmeg  
1 tsp. ground cloves  
2 tbsp. canola oil  
1 cup water

In a medium saucepan

whisk together dry ingredients. Next mix in the water and oil. Stir until a thick batter is formed. Cook the mixture over med-low heat until a thick dough forms. Turn out onto parchment paper and knead until smooth. Makes about 2 cups of dough.
