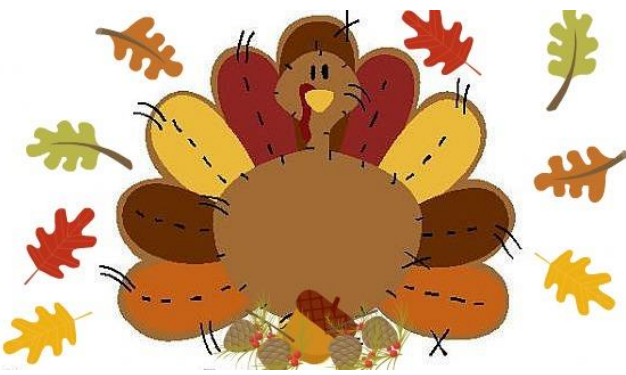
Trains
